#### Status Reports

The 15th Annual GLIN Directors' Meeting opened its first day with the largest number of participants to date, gathering representatives from 21 different nations to share information about efforts over the past year and discuss issues of common interest. Several GLIN members presented their status reports focusing on contributions to the database and new initiatives. Several GLIN members reported about their efforts to promote GLIN within their own institutions, to other agencies in their nations, and beyond their borders as well. Many members have forged agreements with "affiliate" stations that will provide different types of legal materials to the GLIN database. Some described perseverance in the face of obstacles such as political instability and staff turnover. Suggestions for changes and improvements were also offered which will be considered in future development plans for the system. We look forward to hearing more reports on day two.





#### Tribute to Dr. Medina:

Dr. Rubens Medina was honored by the members of the Global Legal Information Network for his role in creating and developing GLIN. A Powerpoint presentation with photographs from as early as 1995 illustrated the many roles that Dr. Medina plaued in the GLIN Network over the years including his participation in GLIN training sessions, in promotional efforts, and presiding at the annual GLIN Directors' meetings. The Supreme Court of Nicaragua, represented by Justice Sergio Cuarezma Terán, presented a plaque to Dr. Medina that was inscribed with the text of a Supreme Court resolution in his honor, A book was given by the GLIN-Uruguay delegation with photographs of their legislature and other landmarks of their country. Finally, a plague was presented by Charles Doyle, Acting Law Librarian of Congress on behalf of the members of the GLIN. In his remarks, Mr. Doule said "....there is one individual who deserves special recognitionwhose contributions to this endeavor are singular... I speak, of course, of Dr. Rubens Medina." The text of the plague, offered on behalf of the members of GLIN, honored Dr. Medina "in recognition of his extraordinary vision, inspiration, dedication, and personal leadership."
