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#### **ABSTRACT:**

The crisis of political representation has several explanations, including the collapse of trust in political institutions and theweakening of the role of the party as an intermediary betweenvoters and elected representatives. This is counterbalanced by astrategy of individual representation pursued by politicians. Thisarticle aims to examine representation in Italy through a highlyinnovative approach, that of the strategic communication of theelected during the electoral campaign and in office: not only theparliamentary work of the elected, but also the overall analysis of the electoral campaign and constituency communication. Thestudy identifies changes in representation, including functionaland thematic autonomy from the party, personalization ofactivities, promotion of independent communication tools, and party-independent agendas. It also highlights the backstagestructuring of a new relationship between voters electedrepresentatives in politics. A study conducted on Italian parliamentarians in Chamber of Deputies (17th Legislature, 2013–18) revealed varying logics of representation based on theirpolitical affiliation, career paths, and individual characteristics.

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
